Buddina State School will again host our highly successful **Buddina Ramp Jam** skate contest. Each year the standard of skating just keeps getting better. Our contest is a great way for groms to have a safe and friendly entry into the skate contest arena.

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS

The contest is open to keen skaters who are used to safely using ramps and performing tricks. There will be 3 divisions with a maximum number of skaters in each division.

Division 1: Boys year 1 to 3 at school

Division 2: Girls year 1 to 6 at school

Division 3: Boys year 4 to 6 at school

Positions in the competition are limited.

Contest will be held Friday 25th October

Entries close as soon as divisions are full. If the division is closed you may enter the reserve list and if a position becomes available it will be given to students in order of the reserve list.

Many prizes to be won and handed out randomly, each competitor will also get a shirt on the day.

Essential Equipment: All competitors must have and wear the following equipment at all times whilst they skate at this facility.

1. Helmet
2. Wrist Guards
3. Elbow Guards
4. Knee Guards

Any skater without this equipment will not be allowed to skate.



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COMPETITION FORMAT

The format of the competition is based on a "jam session" where 4-6 students are skating at the same time for 2 to 3 minutes. Points will be allocated to each skater by the judges for what they demonstrate during their heat. Each skater will compete in at least two separate heats. 50% progression of the highest scores after the first 2 heats.

Cost: \$45 per skater

Date: Friday 25th October

Time: Division 1 and 2 will commence at 9.00am
Division 3 will commence around 11.00am

Attire: Full school uniform must be worn.

Venue: Buddina State School (Tumut Street Buddina) in the school hall.

Lunch: Please bring your own food. Food cannot be eaten in the hall.

Event will be supervised by Buddina teachers, although parents are required to responsible for their children.
